724 people have been referred to diversion for DV charges

39% Female
61% Male



SERVICES PROVIDED

43% DV classes
27% Anger Management
8% Alcohol Screening
3% Mental Health
5% CBT Program
9% Individual Therapy
5% Parenting Classes
10% Addiction Treatment
**The majority of offenders attended multiple services*



ASSESSMENT RESULTS

5.3% *don't feel safe at home*
8.8% *have been afraid of their partner or ex-partner in the past year*
14.5 % *reported witnessing DV as a child*
27.5% *had an ACES score of 4 or higher*



PERFORMANCE OUTCOMES

84% *successfully completed*
98% *did not commit a new crime while in the diversion program*
97% *of defendants who successfully completed diversion committed no new crimes.*

**Defendants who completed diversion had lower recidivism rates (3%) than defendants who failed the program (13%)*
