





NEEDS ASSESSMENT



VALID AND RELIABLE MEASUREMENT Determine training needs and make recommendations for judicial officers, prosecutors, victim advocates, law enforcement, probation, & diversion

Review valid and reliable DV assessments and make recommendations on adoption



Review DV interventions and program standards and make relevant recommendations

#### DETERMINE PRACTICE STANDARDS

The Pinal County DTCS was developed to effectively address the increase in complex cases being diverted and increase the rates of successful diversion completion for the benefits of the offender, victim(s), and communities.




### WOMEN

 Adopt and implement the EBP Beyond Trauma Curriculum: A Healing Journey for Women (2nd ed.). This is an integrated approach to women's trauma treatment, based on theory, research, and clinical experience.



#### MEN

- Consider intervention tailored to client's risk-needresponsivity.
- Send survey to all Pinal county intervention providers.
- Adopt standards applicable to all DV program providers.



### **INTERVENTION STANDARDS:**




Adopt evidence-based program model(s).

**Develop** state or county wide DV Intervention Program Standards.
