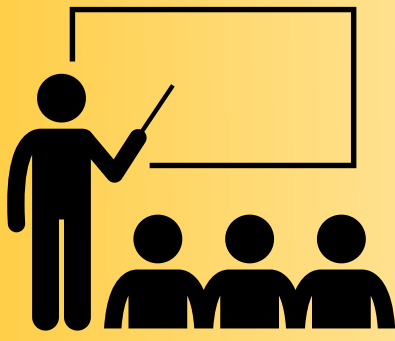


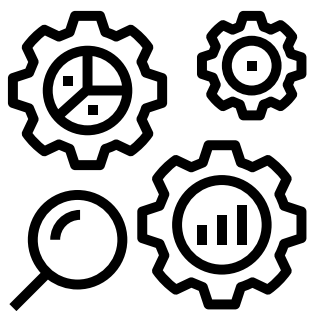

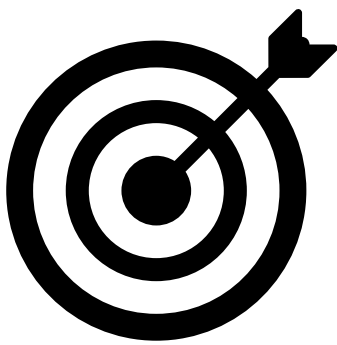
GOALS OF THE JUSTICE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE (DV) WORK GROUP

DTCS workgroups were intended to enhance the content and delivery of the Pinal County Attorney's Office community supervision diversion program.



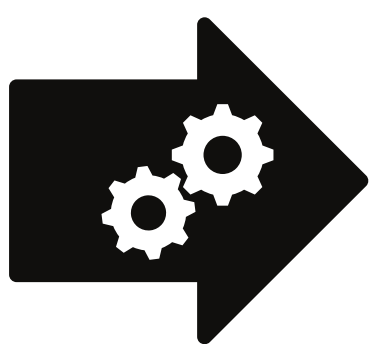
NEEDS ASSESSMENT

Determine training needs and make recommendations for judicial officers, prosecutors, victim advocates, law enforcement, probation, & diversion



VALID AND RELIABLE MEASUREMENT

Review valid and reliable DV assessments and make recommendations on adoption



DETERMINE PRACTICE STANDARDS

Review DV interventions and program standards and make relevant recommendations

The Pinal County DTCS was developed to effectively address the increase in complex cases being diverted and increase the rates of successful diversion completion for the benefits of the offender, victim(s), and communities.

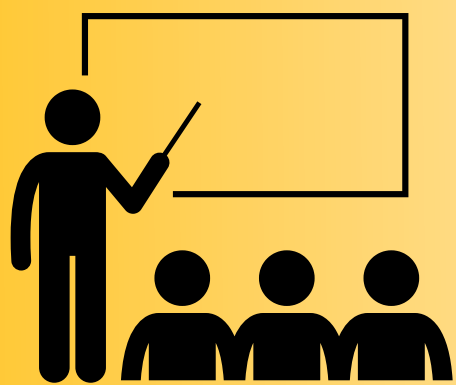

Five disciplines were involved with the training needs assessment

TOP FIVE TRAINING NEEDS FOR EACH DISCIPLINE RELATED TO DV CASES:



JUDICIAL OFFICERS

- Cross-cultural issues
- Social media
- Adult protective services (APS) & law enforcement practice
- High risk alert: Law enforcement risk
- Pro per DV defendants



PROSECUTORS

- APS & law enforcement in DV cases
- Predominant aggressor: Co-defendant or victim
- DV & social media
- Intersection of family & criminal court
- Pro per DV defendants



VICTIM ADVOCATES

- DV probation terms
- Pro per DV defendants
- Cross-jurisdictional issues
- Prior bad act evidence
- Discovery: Victims' rights v. Rule 15

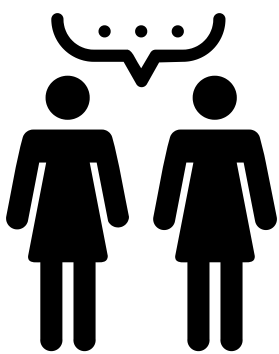

DV INTERVENTIONS:

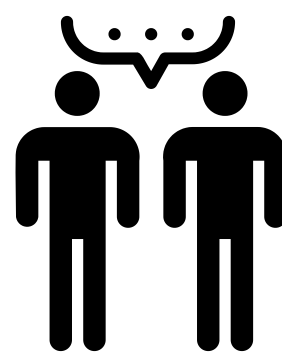
WOMEN

- Adopt and implement the EBP *Beyond Trauma Curriculum: A Healing Journey for Women* (2nd ed.). This is an integrated approach to women's trauma treatment, based on theory, research, and clinical experience.



MEN

- Consider intervention tailored to client's risk-need-responsivity.
- Send survey to all Pinal county intervention providers.
- Adopt standards applicable to all DV program providers.



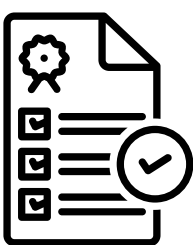
INTERVENTION STANDARDS:



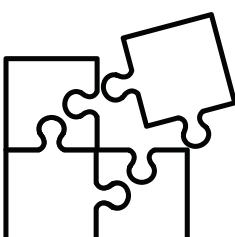
Adopt evidence-based program model(s).



Administer a survey similar to the North American Domestic Violence Intervention Program Survey to DV service providers.



Develop state or county wide DV Intervention Program Standards.



Adopt the Proposed evidence-based standards for domestic violence perpetrator programs in the united states.
